Island Etiquette

There are a few courtesies that are especially helpful in the summer months when our pretty little rock gets suddenly crowded. Summer days are made warmer with a general attitude of thoughtfulness and tolerance.

- If You Come in a Car: PLEASE observe speed limits. The maximum speed anywhere on Islesboro is 40mph, less in most places. We have kids on bikes let loose for the summer, boatloads of people on vacation with their heads happily in the clouds, and an abundance of animals. Please note: The Islesboro Municipal Broadband construction is underway. Be watchful for work vehicles and one-way signs.
- If You Come in on a Bike: Our roads are narrow and full of curves. Please stay in a single file and be aware of the traffic around you. Everything with wheels uses the same lane and a car could be taking a terrible chance trying to pass you on a blind curve that doesn't even look blind to you.
- If You Come on Foot: Ditto above and please walk facing traffic.
- Please Don't Litter: Those paper plates, plastic bags and beer cans make a mess of our beautiful island. Please express your respect and appreciation by not littering. If you are here for the day, expect to take your garbage home with you- the Town does not provide receptacles.
- Ditto Doggy: Please clean up after your dog. Carry bags with you.

There's a lovely grass lawn at the ferry landing that Fido is going to find attractive. Please be mindful that it is widely used by kids and picnickers who don't deserve to be stepping in your dog's do. The Town has installed a dog station for your convenience. Same with cigarette butts- use the receptacles provided, please.

- Please Beware of Ticks: Islesboro has a serious Lyme disease problem so please check yourself and your children whenever you have been playing outdoors. If you find an attached tick, or develop the classic bull's eye rash, play it safe and go to our excellent Health Center. The staff is well-versed in how to help you.
- Take a Deep Breath: Sometimes the ferry gets behind schedule and the lines at the stores get a little long. Please make some allowances for an infrastructure built around a 10-month population of no more than 600...and remember that you came here to relax.
