1. Appoint Harbor Master

2. Open Moseley Dock Float Bids

3. Maddie Dodge Field Tennis Court Rehabilitation Project

Kara Siekman, Summer Recreation Director is applying for a USTA grant to resurface our two 20-year old tennis courts with two coats of asphalt, completely seal the top from moisture along with improving the original drainage plan. The rough estimate for this project is \$130,000 with a grant (amount unknown at this time). We currently have \$18,000 in Capital Reserves. Kara is gathering data to submit the grant. The Board needs to see the grant before it is submitted for a final decision. Donations will be needed to accomplish this project. David Pendleton has been involved with this project.

4. Award Snow Plow Bid

Upon a motion by G. Pendleton and seconded by J. Zlotkowski it was voted to accept the sole bid of Paul Hatch, Jr. for a 5-year contract at \$170,000/year totaling a 5-year amount of \$850,000. **VOTE:** Yes - 5
