

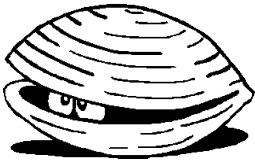

Islesboro Shellfish Harvesting Regulations:

- Everyone, resident or non-resident and over the age of 6 must have a recreational license to harvest shellfish. Licenses are available at the Islesboro Town Office. \$5.00 Resident \$10.00 Non-Resident
- License must be in possession of the licensee when engaged in harvesting
- Harvest shellfish only in open areas (please refer to shellfish map)
- A maximum of 1 peck of soft shell clams or 2 bushels of hen clams is allowed per license per day
- Do not wash clams in closed areas
- Shellfish can only be purchased from licensed commercial harvesters or retail outlets
- The entire Mill Dam in the Ryder's Cove area is open
- Report any potential shellfish violations to Waldo County Dispatch 338-2040
