

GRINDLE POINT PARKING REGULATIONS STARTING: JUNE 15

TIME FRAMES:

REGULATIONS ARE IN EFFECT: JUNE 15 THROUGH LABOR DAY

“Day parking” shall mean from approximately 6:01a.m. to 5:20p.m. any day of the week.

“Night parking” shall mean from approximately 5:30p.m. until 6:00a.m. any night of the week.

PLACARDS:

During days, placards are NOT required on any vehicles in the regulated areas;

During nights, placards ARE REQUIRED in the regulated areas.

Placards will ONLY be issued at the Town Office, Monday-Friday. The vehicle must be present at the Town Office and available for viewing verification by Town Office employees when the placards are issued for it. Placards must be hung on the back side of the rear view mirror.

Motorcycle class vehicles (motorcycles, mopeds, bicycles) and trailers are not required to affix a placard to them unless they are taking up the space/slot of a vehicle.

FINES & VIOLATIONS:

Initial violations are defined as:

Parking overnight in a NO OVERNIGHT slot	Being more than 24 hours in one slot	Vehicle parked in prohibited area
Vehicles obstructing traffic flow	Tires on paved road right of way	No sticker on vehicle when required

If more than 3 tickets are issued on any one placard during the summer season, then the placard will be revoked and will not be reissued until the next June 15th. If the placard (vehicle) is then found in any regulated areas at any time, that vehicle will be towed.

Not paid within 72 hours	\$50	\$250
Not paid within 7 days	\$100	\$350
Not paid after 7 days	Vehicle can be towed without further notice
