HEALTH CENTER ADMINISTRATORS REPORT: Janet passed out a FEE INCREASE SCHEDULE for the Health Center. Increases were mostly in the house calls to the elderly. Chart was done by Janet, Edie and David Runnion-Bareford.

LYME DISEASE: Darreth Roberts reported that Islesboro Health Center will be participating in research studies done by Columbia Lyme Disease Research, with Brian Fallon. Each PA must take a 3 hour exam on tick information. This will improve the diagnostic results. Any person coming in with the TICK RASH, can participate. They will have blood drawn, then checked at 6 weeks and again at 6 months. Anyone participating will receive a \$40.00 gift certificate. Health Center receives \$100.00 per blood draw. Some people recover quickly, others more slowly. Perhaps this blood work can help determine why. There will be a flyer in the Town Calendar Mailing and be in the II NEWS.

Linda Gillies reported on results from deer hunt. On June 11th, there will be a Special Town Meeting, to vote for the hunt to start in November. Archery and Hunters will be both hunting, at same time. IF&W has to approve this if passed. Sharon asked if people treated at off- island doctors for lyme, is this info sent to IHC?
