

Agreement by Resident of Town of Islesboro regarding eligibility for purchase of “Peak Season” ferry tickets at “Off Season” rates 2026

I, _____, [hereinafter “Resident”] in consideration of participating in the program further described herein hereby warrant, attest, and agree as follows:

- I am a resident of the Town of Islesboro and reside at _____, Islesboro, Maine. My email address is _____.
- I am registered to vote in the Town of Islesboro, Maine, which is my sole primary residence, and I do not claim residency anywhere else. I am and/or have been designated the head of the household and will be responsible for the purchase of ferry tickets for the household under this program. Other members of Resident’s my household who I affirm are residents of the town of Islesboro are the following individuals.

- Beginning upon initiation of the program in 2026, during Peak Season (on or about July 1, or date to be announced, – September 30), Resident may purchase up to 10 Maine State Ferry Service “Peak Season” vehicle tickets and, in addition, up to 10 “Peak Season” walk-on tickets for the other members of resident’s household, as listed above, at the “Off Season” Rate.
- Purchase of tickets must be made at the Town Office during regular business hours prior to the day of use to avoid interruption of regular town business. Resident acknowledges that depending upon demand there may be occasions when tickets are not available at the Town Office. Purchase of tickets well in advance of use is strongly encouraged.
- I acknowledge that sales are subject to town budget limitations and it is possible that should the budget for the program approved by voters be reached, the program may be suspended.
- Sales are limited to cash, check and/or credit cards (which will include a 2.5% handling fee.
- All sales are final. NB, MSFS advises that it cannot track these bulk sale tickets. Risk of loss, therefore, rests with the purchaser. Please store tickets in a safe place away from sunlight to avoid ink fading and resulting inability to scan. Those risks rest with buyer as well.
- Resident agrees not to give, transfer, or cause any ferry tickets purchased by Resident at the resident rate, to be used by any person other than members of Resident’s immediate household as listed above.
- Resident agrees that if there is any material change of circumstance regarding Resident’s residence, members of Resident’s immediate household, or any other circumstance that could affect members of Resident’s household residency status, Resident will immediately inform the Town of Islesboro of same.
- Resident agrees that continued ability to purchase tickets is contingent upon compliance with this Agreement.
- Resident agrees that all claims and disputes arising under or relating to this Agreement are to be settled by binding arbitration in the state of Maine. The arbitration shall be conducted on a confidential basis pursuant to the Commercial Arbitration Rules of the American Arbitration Association.
